

What Exams Will Students Take

Grades K-2

- <u>FAST: STAR PM3</u> (Florida Assessments for Student Thinking)
 - Subjects tested: STAR Reading & STAR Mathematics
 - 1 session in 1 day
 - All computer-based exams

Grades 3-5

- <u>FAST: PM3</u> (Florida Assessments for Student Thinking)
 - Subjects tested: FAST Reading & FAST Mathematics
 - 1 session in 1 day
 - All computer-based exams
- *Grade 5 ONLY- Science Statewide Assessment will be administered in 2 days.

ASSESSMENTS MUST BE TAKEN IN PERSON. NO REMOTE TESTING APPROVED BY THE FLDOE

Students will test 3 times per year to monitor student progress

PM3: End of school year

All Kindergarten and Grade 1 students will take the Star Early Literacy for PM1. If a student scores at or above 852 on Star Early Literacy, the student will take Star Reading on subsequent administrations.

All FAST Assessments are administered in one session in one day

All FAST Assessments are computer-based exams

STAR Early Literacy	90 seconds per item	27	10–20 minutes
STAR Reading	60 seconds per item (first 10 items) 120 seconds per item (remaining skill items)	34	15–20 minutes
STAR Math	3 minutes per item	34	20–30 minutes

All FAST Assessments are administered in one session in one day

All FAST Assessments are computer-based exams

Testing windows

- FAST PM3:
 - Grades K-2: April 14- June 2
 - Grades 3-10: May 1- June 2
- 5th Grade Science Statewide Assessment
 - MDCPS testing dates: May 9 & 10
 - All other schools will determine test dates per district

Each testing site will set their own testing dates within testing windows posted above. As soon as they are finalized, you will receive an email with detailed information.


Scale Scores

Testing Reminders

- Arrive to testing site no later than 8:00am and report to the Main Office.
- Bring school ID or a Government issued ID
- Students <u>MUST</u> wear full school uniform. Students without full uniform will not be allowed into building
