WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

Courses taken through a post-secondary institution that simultaneously earn credit towards a high school diploma AND your undergraduate degree.

- Cost of Tuition and Books are FREE
- Courses are fully virtual
- Courses do not have a set schedule self-paced with deadlines
 - Deadlines are hard and at the discretion of the professor
- Dual Enrollment courses carry two bonus points on your GPA
 - Credit is earned with passing grade of course (NOT standardized EXAM)
- CREDITS and Degree are fully transferrable to ALL state of Florida colleges/universities and many out of state post-secondary institutions.

ELIGIBILITY

- Grades 7-11
- Must have completed at least 1 semester of a HS credit course and earned a B or higher (3.0 u.w. GPA)
- APPLY AT Doral.EDU
- Have College Readiness scores



- SLS + (HS ONLY)
 - 2.5 UNWEIGHTED GPA
 - Can participate in several intro level courses without earning college readiness scores or 3.0 GPA






